Dr. Cheung is Professor of Medicine, KY and Betty Ho Chair in Integrative Medicine at University of Toronto (UT) and Senior Physician Scientist at University Health Network (UHN). She has held many awards including the Canadian Institutes of Health Research Senior Investigator award, Canadian Society of Internal Medicine David Sackett Senior Investigator award, Ontario Premier Research Award, UT Eudenie Stuart Mentorship award and UT Eaton Scholar Award for clinical research. She is the PI of CANCOV, RECLAIM, and Long COVID Web and has served as an advisor for Ontario Science Table, PHAC, CITF, CIHR, CADTH and the Chief Science Advisor's Task Force on Post COVID Condition. She obtained her M.D. (1988) from Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, and her PhD (1997) from Harvard University. She is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Canada and has been in clinical practice for >30 years.
