Dr. Kieran Quinn is a General Internist and Palliative Care Clinician-Scientist at Sinai Health System in the Department of Medicine and Institute of Health Policy, Management and Evaluation at the University of Toronto and an Adjunct Scientist at ICES. His research focusses on using advanced analytic methods and administrative data to improve access and delivery of high-quality end-of-life care for patients with terminal noncancer illness, such as heart failure and dementia, and on improving the recognition and care of patients with the post COVID-19 condition (long COVID). Dr. Quinn was awarded the Governor General's Gold Medal for Academic Excellence and the John Charles Polanyi Prize in Physiology and Medicine. His early research success includes over \$27 million dollars in competitive grant funding and 4 CIHR grants as nominated principal applicant. He has multiple publications in high impact journals such as JAMA, JAMA Internal Medicine, BMJ and CMAJ.
