

## INTERPRETATION

### Section 2.1 of the Common General Rules

The following sentence of section 2.1, paragraph 5, of the Common General rules:

**"If one of the above two conditions is not met, applicants must submit one of the following documents in order to be eligible: [...]"**

should be interpreted as follows :

**"If either or both of the above conditions are not met, applicants must submit one of the following documents in order to be eligible: [...]"**

If you have any questions, please contact the person responsible for the program for which you wish to submit a funding application.

Relevant excerpt of article 2.1, p. 14 and 15 :

"[...]"

Applicants are eligible to apply for a master's, doctoral or postdoctoral training award if they:

- Are a Canadian citizen or Canadian permanent resident

AND

- Have a Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec (RAMQ) card that is valid at the competition deadline or proof of application for a RAMQ card and that the card will be valid at the competition deadline.

**If one of the above two conditions is not met, applicants must submit one of the following documents in order to be eligible:**

- In the case of an application for a master's or doctoral training award:
  - o proof of admission to a master's or doctoral program at a Québec university
  - OR
  - o an acceptance form from the research supervisor at a Québec university.
- In the case of an application for a postdoctoral training award:
  - o an acceptance form from the fellowship supervisor at a Québec university.
