

INTERPRETATION

Section 2.1 of the Common General Rules

The following sentence of section 2.1, paragraph 5, of the Common General rules:

"If one of the above two conditions is not met, applicants must submit one of the following documents in order to be eligible: [...]"

should be interpreted as follows:

"If either or both of the above conditions are not met, applicants must submit one of the following documents in order to be eligible: [...]"

If you have any questions, please contact the person responsible for the program for which you wish to submit a funding application.

Relevant excerpt of article 2.1, p. 14 and 15:

"[...]

Applicants are eligible to apply for a master's, doctoral or postdoctoral training award if they:

- Are a Canadian citizen or Canadian permanent resident AND
- Have a Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec (RAMQ) card that is valid at the competition deadline or proof of application for a RAMQ card and that the card will be valid at the competition deadline.

If one of the above two conditions is not met, applicants must submit one of the following documents in order to be eligible:

- In the case of an application for a master's or doctoral training award:
 - o proof of admission to a master's or doctoral program at a Québec university

OR

- o an acceptance form from the research supervisor at a Québec university.
- In the case of an application for a postdoctoral training award:
 - o an acceptance form from the fellowship supervisor at a Québec university.
